

ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING WATER AND

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Alcester, Union County, South Dakota, that a certain ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Regulating Water and Sewer Usage for the City of Alcester", as approved on June 2, 1980, and has been amended from time to time be further amended as follows:

SECTION VIII: DISCONNECTS AND RECONNECTS:

In the event of a disconnect for non-payment of water, sewer or tipping fees, the City shall mail to the consumer a notice advising of the amount payable before the service is to be restored. In making this calculation, any security deposit under the control of the City Finance Officer, shall be applied to any amounts owing to the City.

A service disconnected for non-payment will be reconnected providing the consumer pays in advance:

1. All delinquent water bills and penalties in full.
2. Any other outstanding bills for water, sewer and tipping fees provided by the City of Alcester, subsequent to the date of the delinquent water bill.
3. A reconnect charge of \$50.00.

In addition, in the event that the security deposit funds are applied to the above payment, the security deposit shall be restored to its original amount prior to reconnecting.

ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING
WATER AND SEWER USAGE FOR
THE CITY OF ALCESTER

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Alcester, that an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Regulating Water and Sewer Usage for the City of Alcester" dated July 1, 1980, as amended by various ordinances, the last of which was dated July 1, 1988, be amended as follows:

SECTION I-WATER RATES

The following water rate schedule shall apply to all water purchased from the City of Alcester:

<u>Usage</u>	<u>Water Rate</u>
Minimum bill for 2000 gallons	\$12.70
2,000 gallons @ \$4.35 per thousand	8.70
2,000 gallons @\$3.85 per thousand	7.70
2,000 gallons @ \$3.35 per thousand	6.70
2,000 gallons @ \$2.85 per thousand	5.70
In excess of 10,000 gallons @ \$1.85 per thousand	

The above rates apply, based upon water usages on a monthly a basis. A minimum of \$12.70 per month will be assessed against all water users.

Rates for water users residing outside the city limits of the City of Alcester shall be increased by \$1.00 per month.

The rates for all inoperative meters will be figured based upon the average of the last three months water usages. The consumer shall immediately report any meter malfunction to the City Finance Officer of the City of Alcester.

SECTION XII-EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be effective on the 1st day of July, 2002, and shall apply to all water bills to be paid on the 1st day of August, 2002.


WAIVER OF NOTICE


1. Approve a change order for the sewer plant







**ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE
PROCEDURE FOR DETERMINING EQUITABLE SERVICE CHARGES TO BE
LEVIED ON ALL USERS WHICH DISCHARGE WASTE WATER TO THE WASTE
WATER TO THE WASTE WATER SYSTEM OPERATED BY THE CITY OF
ALCESTER, SOUTH DAKOTA AND PROVIDING CERTAIN PROHIBITIONS**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Alcester, Union County, South Dakota, that a certain ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Establishing The Procedure For Determining Equitable Service Charges To Be Levied On All Users Which Discharge Waste Water To the Waste Water System Operated By The City Of Alcester, South Dakota And Providing Certain Prohibitions" as originally approved and adopted on May 5, 1986 and as subsequently, from time to time, amended, be further amended as follows:

SECTION 8: USERS WASTEWATER RATES AND CHARGES:

The City hereby establishes rates and charges for all residential users as follows:

(1.) Residential users shall be billed monthly. The charge shall be based upon the average monthly water usage during the January and February monthly billing period and shall be effective on March 1, subsequent thereto and remain the same for the March through February monthly billing periods for the following year except as hereinafter provided. The charge shall be adjusted annually to reflect any changes in water usage during the January and February monthly billing period.

(1a.) In the case of major residential users, as determined by the City of Alcester, the monthly sewer charge shall be calculated based upon the actual monthly water usage. The water meter shall be read on a monthly basis and the monthly wastewater billing determined as hereinafter set forth.

(2.) The rate for each monthly billing shall be \$7.00 for each 1000 gallons, or major fraction thereof, of the average monthly water metered to the user during the January and February monthly billing periods for residential users and each month for major residential users except as hereinafter provided. The minimum charge shall be \$14.00 per month.

(3.) The charge for residential users not receiving water service from the City water system, or where there is no prior water usage, shall be based upon estimates prepared by the City.

(4.) The charge for residential users having substantially higher or lower volumes of water consumption, than that of the average monthly water usage during the January and February monthly averaging periods, may be adjusted based upon the water metered to the user during such monthly billing periods as determined by the City of Alcester.

(5.) The charge for residential users not receiving water service from the City water system during a complete calendar month do to extended absences from the City of Alcester shall be the minimum sewer rate per month as may from time to time be established by the City Council of the City of Alcester. For the purposes of this subsection, this rate shall apply only in the event that the extended absence exists for a period of 60 days and prior to

its commencement, the residential water user has notified the City of its absence at least one week in advance and has requested that its water be shut off pursuant to the provisions of the ordinances of the City of Alcester.

The City hereby establishes rates of charge for all non-residential (industrial) users as follows:

(1.) Non-residential users shall be billed monthly. The charge shall be based on the metered waste volume as determined by water consumed and metered, and the strength of waste discharged to the wastewater system.

(2.) The charge for each monthly billing period shall be negotiated on an individual basis with the non-residential user and calculated giving due consideration to the ability of the City of Alcester to treat the waste and under such terms and conditions as the City of Alcester deems appropriate according to the purposes of this ordinance as set forth herein.

The City of Alcester, may from time to time enter into contracts to accept wastewater from non-residential users (industries) who are not residents of the City of Alcester under such terms and conditions as it deems appropriate according to the purposes of this ordinance as set forth herein.

(3.) This paragraph shall be deleted.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the procedure for calculating major residential users monthly ~~water bill~~ ^{sewer bill} shall become effective January 1, 2005, with the first payments to be made in February, 2005.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the effective date of the sewer rate increase shall be March 1, 2005, with the first payment of the amended rates to be made on the April, 2005 billing.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the remaining sections of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this ordinance.

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 6.0406
OF THE CITY OF ALCESTER

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City Alcester, Union County, South Dakota, that Ordinance No. 6.0406 be amended to read as follows:

B. As an alternative to impounding the dog in the animal shelter, if said, dog cannot be captured and the owner is known to the animal warden or police officer, then in that case, a citation may be issued to the owner that his dog is in violation of this Section, which said citation shall state the violation date, time, location, breed, and color of dog, license number if known, and the name and address of the owner of said dog. Said citation shall direct the owner of said dog to appear before the magistrate court to answer the charge of permitting the dog to run at large or such other violation as appears on the ticket. The minimum fine for a first violation shall be \$25.00. The minimum fine for second violation shall be \$100.00 with all subsequent offenses to carry a minimum fine of \$200.00 and shall not exceed the maximum fine authorized for violation of City Ordinance. For the purpose of determining offenses, the 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of violation shall be considered.


