

Alcester Golf Course General Rules

These rules were made to accommodate the general public.

General Rules:

1. Before golfers begin, sign in at club house. (Bar area of Clubhouse Grill)
2. Proper golf etiquette should be used on course at all times.
3. Golf memberships need to be paid when course opens. (May 1) Anyone that has not paid from previous year must pay past year and present year before they Golf.
4. Golf membership tags remain on bags. Rules of membership purchased are followed.

Cart Rules:

1. Anyone who rents a golf cart must be 16 years of age and older.
2. **Drivers of carts must be at least 16 years of age.** Drivers under the age of 16 may operate a golf cart provided there is an adult age 21 or older on the front supervising the minor. (Insurance Guidelines)
3. Carts shall be operated with the utmost courtesy, care and consideration of safety for others. Anyone caught driving in an unsafe manner will lose the privilege to have a golf cart on property.
4. The owner of the golf cart is responsible for their cart. This includes whoever you allow to operate your cart.
5. Please follow carts guidelines to number of persons on cart.
6. Please clean up trash when done using your cart.

We want the Alcester Golf Course to be a "Great" place to golf and stays clean and safe for all.

Discipline Action for Minors on Golf Course if needed.

Young golfers are very welcome on the Golf Course. We want Golf to become a life-time sport that they will enjoy. Often young golfers are golfing without an adult. We ask for respect for other golfers and the golf course property. Under most circumstances young golfers will receive a warning before action is taken.

- I. Guidelines for dealing with discipline:
 - a. 1st Offense- Kicked off course for rest of day
 - b. 2nd Offense- Kicked off course for up to 3 days at golf management discretion.
 - c. 3rd Offense- Kicked out for golf season/or with parent only.
2. If a minor is suspended from the Golf Course for a day or longer, parents will be notified as soon as possible. A discipline report will be sent home with a copy to be signed by the parent before the minor will be permitted to return to golf course.
3. When kicked out minor will be asked to leave Golf Course property.
4. If a parent or guardian has concerns with discipline taken, the concern must be taken to the City Council or Mayor. The Council or Mayor will follow-up with the Golf Course management in question.
