

REGULAR MEETING OF THE ALCESTER CITY COUNCIL

The Alcester City Council held their regular City Council Meeting on Monday, December 21, 2020. Vice President Linda Talbott called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm with the following Council members present: Marcus Ireland, Darla Reppe and Melissa Kay via telephone. Also present during the meeting were Patricia Jurrens, Wanda Halverson, Austin Schuller, Gordon Richard, and Vickie Larsen. All stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Linda Talbott postponed discussion on the following: Legal Updates, 2021 Resolution of Fees, COVID-19 Quarantine Policy, Mask Discussion and Executive Session for Personnel until the January 4, 2020 meeting. Marcus Ireland made a motion to approve the agenda as amended; Darla Reppe seconded it. Roll Call vote, four voted aye.

For Public Input – Vickie Larsen addressed the Council with concerns regarding Executive Session, False Swearing, and Wastewater Funding. Darla Reppe & Marcus Ireland shared a concern with a street issue on Lincoln Circle. This concluded Public Input.

Jeff Nohava was not in attendance for the Alcester EMS update.

Regarding the pumps for the Wastewater plant – the pumps are in Chicago and the city can expect delivery January 2021.

Officer Schuller was available to provide the Police Updates. Officer Schuller reviewed the November Stats – stating it was a normal stat month. Officer Schuller provided an update on the equipment ordered thru the CARES act which included a Body Camera, a Portable Radio and other PPE. This concluded Police Department Updates.

Darla Reppe made a motion to remove Michele Norling from the Friends of the Library Bank Account and CD Account and to add Paige German to the Friends of the Library Bank Account and CD Account. Marcus Ireland seconded it. Roll Call vote, four voted aye.

Marcus Ireland made a motion to approve the Second Reading of *Ordinance No 2020-18, An Ordinance of the City of Alcester, SD, Rezoning Property at 500 Dakota Street, Original Alcester City, Block 23, Tract 1, from the R: Residential District to the PD: Planned Development District and Amending the Official Zoning Map of the City of Alcester*. Darla Reppe seconded it. Roll call vote, four voted aye.

Darla Reppe made a motion to approve the Second Reading of the Supplemental Appropriations Ordinance 2020-19; Marcus Ireland seconded it. Roll call vote, four voted aye.

No Executive Session.

Marcus Ireland made a motion to adjourn, Darla Reppe seconded it. Roll call vote, four voted aye. Meeting adjourned at 6:17 pm.
