

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #11.0205 OF THE CITY OF ALCESTER,  
ALCESTER, SOUTH DAKOTA

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City council of the City Alcester, Union County, South Dakota, that a certain ordinance of the City of Alcester relating to security deposits for water, sewer and garbage collection services Section 11.0205 as amended on January 15, 1991 be amended to read as follows:

11.0205        DEPOSIT REQUIRED

(A) Security Deposit: All consumers who use water, sewer or garbage services furnished by or on behalf of the City of Alcester shall make a security deposit in the amount of \$100.00 prior to receiving the City services.

(B) Deposit Refund: No interest shall be paid on security deposits. The security deposit shall be retained until service is terminated or for a period of 36 months, whichever occurs first, provided the consumer is in good standing. The security deposit shall be refunded upon the consumer attaining 36 continuous months of good standing status or upon termination of service by the consumer provided all bills, charges and indebtedness due the City of Alcester are paid in full.

(B)(1) Good Standing: Good standing as used herein shall mean that the consumer shall have paid on a timely basis, all charges and indebtedness due the City of Alcester.

(C) In the event the consumer fails to timely pay any amounts due the City of Alcester, then the City, at its option, may apply any funds in the security deposit to pay said indebtedness. If security deposit funds are applied, notice of the application shall be given in writing to the consumer along with a notice that said security deposit funds shall be restored by the due date of the next utility bill. Failure to so restore said security deposit fund shall subject the consumer to disconnect pursuant to City ordinance.

(D) This ordinance applies to all new consumers to the Alcester system after the effective date of this ordinance.

(E) Security deposits shall not be required of water consumers who are consumers of the Alcester water, sewer or garbage services on the effective date of this ordinance providing they are not delinquent on any water, sewer or garbage fees.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City council of the City Alcester, Union County, South Dakota, that a certain ordinance of the City of Alcester relating to security deposits for water, sewer and garbage collection services Section 11.0205 as amended on January 15, 1991 be amended to read as follows:

11.0205        DEPOSIT REQUIRED

If security deposit funds are applied, notice of the application shall be given in writing to the consumer along with a notice that said security deposit funds shall be restored by the due date of the next utility bill. Failure to so restore said security deposit fund shall subject the consumer to disconnect pursuant to City ordinance.

(D) This ordinance applies to all new consumers to the Alcester system after the effective date of this ordinance.

(E) Security deposits shall not be required of water consumers who are consumers of the Alcester water, sewer or garbage services on the effective date of this ordinance providing they are not delinquent on any water, sewer or garbage fees.
