- 6.0404. LICENSE FEE: The applicant shall at the time of making application for a license, pay to the City Finance Officer of the City of Alcester, an annual license fee in the sum of \$10.00 per dog for such license. It shall be the duty of the City Finance Officer, at the time of the issuance of the license herein provided for, to furnish and deliver to said applicant a metallic tag for each dog for which such license is issued. Upon the tag, shall be stamped or engraved the registered number of the dog and the year registered. It shall be the duty of the owner to place a collar around the neck of the dog and the metallic tag shall be securely fastened to the collar. In the event of the loss of any tag so issued, the City Finance Officer is authorized to issue a duplicate tag at no additional cost to the owner upon satisfactory proof by the owner that said metallic tag has been lost. It is the duty of the owner of any licensed dog to assure proper tagging of said animal as set forth herein. The failure to do shall be a violation of this ordinance.

This amendment to Section 6.0404 shall be effective on December 1, 2010, for licenses to be issued for the calendar year 2011.

SECTION VIII: DISCONNECTS AND RECONNECTS:

In the event of a disconnect for non-payment of water, sewer or tipping fees, the City shall mail to the consumer a notice advising of the amount payable before the service is to be restored. In making this calculation, any security deposit under the control of the City Finance Officer, shall be applied to any amounts owing to the City.

A service disconnected for non-payment will be reconnected providing the consumer pays in advance:

1. All delinquent water bills and penalties in full.
2. Any other outstanding bills for water, sewer and tipping fees provided by the City of Alcester, subsequent to the date of the delinquent water bill.
3. A reconnect charge of \$50.00.

In addition, in the event that the security deposit funds are applied to the above payment, the security deposit shall be restored to its original amount prior to reconnecting.

SECTION VI: PENALTY

User whose bill is not paid or postmarked by or on the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month shall be charged a penalty of \$5.00. The normal penalty date will be waived when the 10<sup>th</sup> falls on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday. In that event the next normal working day for the postal department shall be considered the penalty date.

SECTION VIII: DISCONNECTS AND RECONNECTS.

In the event of a disconnect for a non payment of water, sewer or tipping fees, the City shall mail to the consumer a notice advising of the amount payable before the service is to restored. In making this calculation, any security deposit under the control of the City finance officer shall be applied to any amounts owing the City of Alcester.

A service, disconnected for non-payment, will be reconnected, provided the consumer pays in advance: (1) All delinquent water bills and penalties in full, (2) Any other outstanding bill for water, sewer and tipping fees provided by the City of Alcester subsequent to the date of the delinquent water bill and (3) A reconnect charge of \$20.00. In addition, in the event that security deposit funds are applied to the above payment, the security deposit shall be restored to its original amount prior to reconnecting.
